Trees- Fruiting and Nuts	Description
Almond – All-In-One	H-12-15'x15-20' Pink white flowers in the Spring. Self-pollinating. Ripens in September. Heat tolerant.
Almond – Halls Hardy	H-15-18' This is a cross of almond and peach with large showy pink blossoms. The nuts are tasty with a hint of bitter almond flavor. Likes well-drained soil, heat tolerant and is self-fertile.
Almond – Ne Plus	H-10-12'. Late harvest season. Bloom time is in early spring with nuts maturing in summer. Needs pollinizer
Apple Espalier Combinations	Various combinations may include: Fuji, Gala, Gravenstein, Honeycrisp, Red Delicious, Red McIntosh, Summer Red, Red Delicious, Yellow Delicious, and Yellow Transport.
Apple – Assorted Combinations	Various combinations may include: Anna, Beverly Hills, Cortland, Dorsett, Einshimer, Granny Smith, Red McIntosh, Spartan, Summer Red, Yellow Delicious, and Yellow Transport.
Apple – Arkansas – Black -SD	Late harvest season, apple purplish red, flesh is hard and crisp, good for applesauce.
Apple - Elinshimer	Early-season harvest. A medium sized apple that has an appearance similar to that of the Golden Delicious apple. The skin has a greenish-yellow hue that has blush tones of red. Good for baking.
Apple – Golden Sentinel Columnar	White spring flowers followed by very large and attractive solid golden yellow fruit. Sweet, juicy and delicious. Disease resistant and productive.
Apple- Lodi – SD	Early season harvest. Fruit is large and thick skin is greenish yellow. Apple is soft and tart. Good for sauces and pies.
Apple – Yellow Delicious - SD	Late harvest season, fruit is medium to large, skin color yellow with pink blush, apple is crisp, firm, good for fresh eating and cooking, bears young.
Cherry – Black Tartan – SD	Early harvest season, fruit is medium size, skin color is bright purplish black, cherry is firm and sweet, one of the earliest cherries, pollinizer could be any sweet cherry.
Cherry – Meteor – SD	Hardy red cherry with large, tart, juicy and completely freestone fruits. Ripens in late July. The tree grows only 10 to 12 feet tall. Resistant to Leaf Spot.
Cherry - Montmorency	Mid-harvest season, tree is hardy, fruit is large, skin color is bright red, cherry's flavor is tart, the best pie cherry, used commercially.
Peach – Assorted Varieties	
Pear – Anjou D	Mid-harvest season, tree is upright and slow bearing, fruit is large, skin color is light green, pear has fine texture and is mild and juicy, good for fresh eating.
Pear – Bartlett UD	Early harvest season, vigorous tree, fruit medium to large, skin color green and ripens to a yellow, pear is sweet and tender, good for fresh eating and canning. H-3-6'

Trees- Fruiting and Nuts	Description
Pear – Seckel -D	Also called 'Sugar Pear' because of its sugary sweetness. The fruit is small with a rich yellow-brown skin when ripe. The tree is vigorous, hardy and fire blight resistant. Ripens early August.
Plum – Blue Damson	Late-season harvest. Small tree. Small fruit with dark purple skin. Plum is juicy and tart. Great for jam and jellies.
Walnut - Caroathian	Fast growing tree and will survive in cold weather. Heat tolerant. Ripens in October. Nuts are large that cracks easily. Delicious flavor. For proper pollination plant two trees or another grafted English walnut variety.

Trees- Ornamentals	Description
Birch – River Clump	H-40'x35' Broad pyramid to rounded shape. Dark green leaves turning yellow to gold in the fall. Resistance to Bronze birch borer and Japanese beetle.
Cherry – Canada Red Select	H-20-25'x18-20' Small white flowers in the spring followed by small black fruit. Leaves turn red, burgundy and purple in the fall. Prefers full sun in well-drained soil.
Cherry – Double Weeping	H-15-20'x15-20' Large magenta buds on graceful weeping boughs open to double pink flowers, bronze leaves appear after blooms and mature to green. Requires summer watering.
Cherry – Pink Snow Shower Weeping	H-25'x 20-25' Masses of double pink flowers cover the graceful, weeping branches in early spring followed by lush green foliage that becomes deep golden in fall. Full sun and regular water.
Cherry – Snow Fountain 'Snowfozam'	H-8'-15' Slow-growing has cascading branches that dip to the ground, giving the appearance of a white snow fountain when covered with pure white flowers in early spring. Flowers give way to small, sparse, black, inedible fruits. Dark green leaves.
Crabapple – Floribunda	H-15-25'x20-30' Pale pink flowers in the spring followed by small yellowish crabapples with a red blush. Full sun. Medium water.
Crabapple – 'Louisa' Weeping	H-12-15'x12-15' Very decorative graceful weeping crab with true pink blossoms, dark glossy green leaves, yellow 3/8" fruit in fall.
Crabapple – Sargentina	H-4-5'x4-5' White flowers appear in the spring with small red crabapples in the fall. Leaves turn yellow in the fall. Full sun. Medium water.
Goldenchain vossi	H-25-30' Green bark w/ bright green leaves, bears yellow sweet pea-shaped flowers in hanging clusters.
Linden – Green Spire	H-50-70'x25-40'. Tiny yellow flowers appear in summer. Leaves are large, round, glossy green which turn bright yellow in the fall. Prefers part sun.
Maple – Autumn Blaze / Jeffersred	H-40-50'x30-40' Full or partial sun. Soil conditions: Adaptable. Fast growing maple. Highly disease resistant. Brilliant red fall color.
Maple – Crimson King	H-30-40'x 35'. Yellow flowers in the spring. Leaves are dark maroon and retain their color all summer. Full to partial sun.

Trees- Ornamentals	Description
Maple – Fairview Flame	H-40-50'x30-40'. Scarlet red leaves on grey bark in the fall. Tolerates moist wet soil. Prefers sun to part shade with regular water.
Maple – Hedge	H-30-40'x30-40' Full sun, slow growth, prefers good drainage, drought tolerant. Green leaves that turns yellow in the fall. Bark is corky with age.
Ninebark 'Center Glow'	H-8-10'x6-8' White to pink flower in the spring. The leaves are dark purple with green center. Prefers full sun to part shade with regular water.
Plum - Krauter Vesuvius Purple Leaf	H-15-20'x10-25' Quick growing with soft pink blossoms in the spring and bright red plums the size of cherries in the fall.
Poplar - Bolleana	H-40-50'x20-30' Tree grows in narrow columnar form. Leaf is green and underside is silvery color. Leaves turn yellow in the fall. Prefers full sun in well-drained soil.
Poplar - Siouxland	H-70-100' Green foliage that turn yellow in fall. Seedless with dark green leaves. Resistance to leaf rust. Prefers full sun in well-drained soil.
Redbud	H-30' Redbuds are exceptionally attractive, spring-blooming trees. A fast-growing plant with hundreds of small, bright purple flowers in the early spring, before their heart shaped leaves appear.
Willow – Babylonica Green	H-35-45' Leaves are bright green and weep gracefully turning yellow in the fall. Full sun to part shade in well-drained soil.
Willow – Globe Navaho	H-20-35'x20-30' Hardy, large spreading, rounded umbrella-shaped head, slender, green leaves turn yellow in fall.
Willow – Pink Pussy Willow	H-8-10'x8' Fat, fluffy silver-pink fuzzy clusters bloom in early April. Dark green leaves after the bloom. Plant full sun and moist soil
Weeping Pussy Willow	H-4-5'x5-6' Strong weeping habit with drooping branches is adorned with extra-large, silver-gray catkins which turn bright yellow and can last for nearly a month in late winter and early spring. Excellent for early bee pollen.

Assorted potted plants	Description
Ceanothus – Victoria	H-9'x10-12' Evergreen shrub with dark blue flowers appear in spring. Prefers full sun with regular water until established. Great for hedges.
Hawthorn – Washington	H-25-35'x25-35' White flowers appear in late spring followed by green leaves which turn to orange and red in the fall. Small red berries in the fall. There are sharp thorns and trees are used as security hedges.
Persian Spire – Ironwood (Columnar)	H-20-25'x10-12' In the spring, leaves have a purple tinge. By summer the leaves turn dark emerald green. In the fall the leaves turn yellow, orange, burgundy and red. Prefers full sun in moist well-drained soil.
Snowbell Japanese Weeping Pink	H-8'-10'x4-5' Full sun to partial shade. Pink flowers. Green leaves turn bright yellow in the fall.

Shrubs	Description
Chokecherry - Canada Red Select	Shrub with bright green leaves turns bright reddish purple through-out the growing season. Partial to full sun. Small white flowers in the spring followed by small black fruit. Used for erosion control, privacy screen and windbreak.
Dogwood - Cardinal Red Osier	H-8-10'x10' In late spring tiny white flowers appear. Green leaves turn red-purple in the fall and then in winter, the branches turn bright red. Loves wet soil. Full or part sun.
Purple Leaf Sand Cherry cistena	H-6-8'x5-6' Fragrant pink flowers appear in spring. Leaves will change red-bronze in the fall. Part shade to full sun. Prefers well drained soil.
Quince - Jet Blue Flowering	H-3-4'x3-4'. A compact flowering quince hybrid cultivar that typically grows only to 2-4' tall., dense, twiggy, spiny, deciduous shrub noted for its pure white, early spring flowers and its compact, broad-spreading habit.
Smoke Tree Royal Purple	Summer pinkish purple, smoke-like airy seed clusters backed by purple leaves which turn red in the fall. Prefers full sun and once established water deeply occasionally.
Spirea - Anthony Waterer	H-2-3'x2-4'. Full sun. The foliage is deciduous, and at first the leaves are a wine-red to maroon, then in the fall, they mature into a dark green.
Willow - Dwarf Artic Blue	H-3-4'x3-6' Blue-green leaves sway in the wind, great for that wet spot where nothing will grow. Good at fences, corners and garden gates.
